South Bank Station - Platform 1 Upgrade, QLD



South Bank Station is located in Brisbane, between Vulture and Tribute Street on the Gold Coast Line. The station is bound by a major residential and commercial development "South Point" situated in Grey Street. This development abuts the eastern boundary and provides the principal entry point to the platform.

Requirements

The General Project Scope included providing a main awning roof the length of the platform between the Vulture Street entry and the Tribute Street stair. The awning is set back 300mm from the yellow line and generally follows the fall of the platform.

The main awning has been designed as a double cantilever butterfly roof, with the front half of the roof as a consistent cantilever of 2700mm while the rear varied to suit the site shape.

The roofing material required for the project needed to be certified non-combustible panel in accordance with NCC 2019 C1.9(e).






Delta DualCore being installed
